

Ordinance No. 2176

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING INTERCONNECTION STANDARDS FOR INSTALLATION AND PARALLEL OPERATION OF CUSTOMER OWNED RESIDENTIAL AND CUSTOMER OWNED COMMERCIAL RENEWABLE ENERGY GENERATION FACILITIES

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, said Ordinance approved standards and procedures necessary for the health, safety and welfare of the citizens and city employees for the interconnection of such capacity with the City's electrical system, and

WHEREAS, the governing body finds that new standards and procedures should be adopted;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF AUGUSTA, KANSAS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. There is hereby adopted Interconnection Standards for Installation and Parallel Operation of Customer-Owned Renewable Electric Generation Facilities Dated July 6, 2021

SECTION 2: The adopted Interconnection Standards for Installation and Parallel Operation of Customer-Owned Renewable Electric Generation Facilities Dated July 6, 2021 may be amended and modified in whole or in part by the Governing Body of the City of Augusta, Kansas, as deemed appropriate by the Governing Body.


SECTION 3: This ordinance shall be effective upon its adoption and publication on the city website (www.augustaks.org), the City of Augusta, Kansas official city newspaper.
