RESOLUTION NO. 2023-05

A RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF AUGUSTA, KANSAS, AUTHORIZING CITY STAFF TO APPLY TO THE KANSAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION SPRING 2023 COST SHARE PROGRAM AND DELEGATING AUTHORITY TO THE CITY MANAGER TO SIGN THE APPLICATION.

WHEREAS, Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) Cost Share Program provides financial assistance to local entities for transportation projects that improve safety, support job retention and growth, improve access or mobility, relieve congestion and help areas across the state improve the transportation system; and

WHEREAS, the Cost Share Program is one of KDOT's most flexible funding opportunities for communities, allowing communities to apply for assistance with a wide range of highway, local road, bridge, rail, airport, bicycle, pedestrian and public transit projects – as long as they can provide at least a 15 percent local cash match; and

WHEREAS, KDOT Spring Cost Share Program is accepting applications until March 23, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the City has previously been awarded Cost Share funding for the Redbud Trail Project between Lulu and Frisco Streets; and

WHEREAS, the City's share of obligation related to this program should the application be accepted could come from bond issuance paid by KDOT Federal Fund Exchange dollars.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF AUGUSTA, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. The City Council demonstrates its support for the submittal of an application to the Kansas Department of Transportation Spring 2023 Cost Share Program for construction of a pedestrian bridge over HWY 54/400.


SECTION 2. The City Council authorizes the City Manager to sign the application.
